

**WHEATON SANITARY DISTRICT
ORDINANCE NO. 510**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING USER CHARGE ORDINANCE
NO. 194 "USER CHARGE RATE ORDINANCE" AS AMENDED**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Wheaton Sanitary District did on the 16th day of December, 1976, adopt an Ordinance No. 194 establishing the User Charge Rate, which Ordinance, as amended, is now in full force and effect; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has adopted an estimate of the cost of operation, maintenance and replacement for the fiscal year commencing May 1, 2009 through April 30, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees, for the purpose of amending the User Charge Rate Ordinance, determined and declared:

- a. The projected yearly cost of operation, maintenance and replacement of the proportion of the works of the system to waste volume by Biochemical Oxygen Demand (BOD) and Suspended Solids, and attributable to use based on volume and strength;
- b. The distribution of costs applicable to each user class based on volume and strength;
- c. The user charge cost per unit of measurement applicable to each user class; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees deems it expedient and advisable and in the best interest of the public to amend the user charge rates set forth in Ordinance No. 194, as amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Wheaton Sanitary District, Wheaton, DuPage County, Illinois that Section 1 of Ordinance No. 194, as amended, be and hereby is amended by substituting in lieu thereof the following:

SECTION 1: A. Rates - Until such time as rescinded by amendment to this Ordinance, the user charge rates henceforth from the effective date of this Ordinance shall be as follows:

SECTION 1: B. Base Charge – A base charge of \$6.15 per month shall be billed to all customers.

SECTION 1: C. Sewer Collector System Maintenance Charges

1. Wheaton Sanitary District Collector System

There shall be added to each customer billing for users connected to the sanitary sewer collector system owned and operated by the Wheaton Sanitary District charges to defray the cost of maintenance of the sanitary sewer collector system as follows:

SECTION 1: D. Water Meter Maintenance Charges - There shall be added to each customer billing for users who have water meters installed and maintained by the Wheaton Sanitary District charges to defray the cost of maintenance and replacement of the water meters as follows:

SECTION 1: E. Capital Improvements Charge - There shall be added to each customer billing to defray the cost of future capital improvements benefiting all District users as follows:

SECTION 1: F. Interceptor Sewer Maintenance - There shall be added to each customer billing to defray the cost of interceptor sewer operation and maintenance as follows:

Minimum Charge (Based on 2,000 gallons use per month)	\$0.03 per month

SECTION 1: G. Water Pollution Revolving Fund Loan Repayment - There shall be added to each customer billing to defray the cost of repayment of loans from the Illinois Water Pollution Revolving Loan Fund as follows:

SECTION 1: H. Replacement Fund Charge – There shall be added to each customer billing for Replacement Fund Reserves as follows:

SECTION 1: I Arrowhead Excess Flow Pump Station. There shall be added to each customer billing tributary to the Arrowhead Gravity Sewer to defray the cost of construction of the Arrowhead Excess Flow Pump Station as follows:

SECTION 1: J Debt Service. There shall be added to each customer billing to defray the cost of repaying long term debt incurred by the District in financing capital improvements as follows:

SECTION 2: REPEALER. All ordinances, or part of ordinances, in conflict herewith be and are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: SEVERABILITY. This ordinance is severable and invalidity or unconstitutionality of any portion thereof shall not affect the remaining portions thereof.

SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE: This Amendment shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law, for all user charges billed on or after May 1, 2009.
