The final page of our PDOP concluded that process changes were infeasible, ineffective using BIOWIN modeling, or over the cost threshold.

Steps we have completed other than process changes are:

- 1) 2018, A Community Outreach Phosphorus pamphlet was added to our website @ Wheaton Sanitary District/About WSD/News—Reduce your phosphorus impact.
- 2) We host several grade, middle, and high school tours to keep students and teachers informed. As well as adult organizations, (rotary clubs, operator groups, oversees delegations.)
- 3) Carwash waste hauled to a landfill.
- 4) 2018 trialed Ferric Chloride. Corroded feed lines and equipment -messy.
- 5) 2019 our one SU closed and move to Elgin.
- 6) Member DuPage River Salt Creek workgroup-2022 opted out of the 3-year special condition extension. Took 1mg/L P limit starting 2027.
- 7) Illinois Association of Wastewater Agencies member-contribute data to various studies.
