Dear Wheaton Residents:

This is a notice of upcoming work within Part D of the North Side Interceptor (NSI) project, which includes the area between Liberty Drive and Manchester Road. Construction along Knollwood Drive is expected to start on September 12, 2022.

Construction will include sanitary sewer installation, water service replacement, storm sewer culvert replacement, pavement reconstruction and parkway restoration. The General Contractor, Benchmark Construction, will start their work by implementing Traffic Control, which will disrupt access to residents along Knollwood for the entire duration of the work.

Access along Knollwood Drive will be limited to local traffic only during working hours and overnight on-street parking will be prohibited. The District will coordinate overnight on-street parking along Liberty Drive and Woodlawn Street with the City of Wheaton. The Contractor will maintain property access during construction, except during short periods when sewer and water work is occurring within a particular driveway.

The Wheaton Sanitary District (WSD) will hold an open house on-site Wednesday, September 7th at 6P.M. for Knollwood Drive residents to look over the Plans and meet the District's Engineers, Baxter & Woodman, responsible for managing the construction work. Please plan to attend the open house or notify the District if you have any concerns or special access requirements.


