Subject: Northside Interceptor Sewer Replacement Project

Construction through Surrounding Areas

MEMO

Please be informed starting Wednesday 10/19 Wheaton Sanitary District (WSD) will be doing heavy construction regarding its Northside Interceptor (NSI) Sewer Replacement Program on Dorchester Ave between the creek and Childs St.

- We expect the street to be closed to all but local residents for a minimum of 3-4 weeks between Childs Street and Lakeside Street
- Initial work will be trenchless pipe instillation under the creek with no issues accessing driveways, but the road will be completely closed at the creek
- Following the trenchless pipe instillation there will be open cut pipe instillation.
- You will be specifically notified on an individual basis if we expect access to your driveway
 to be temporarily unavailable or potentially a temporary disruption to your potable water
 service
- Following installation of the sanitary sewer, a temporary hard surface pavement or permanent road and parkway restoration will occur before winter
- Permanent restoration includes new driveway aprons and newly seeded parkways, along with new culvert pipes
- Garbage pickup time will remain on the same day as it is but pickup time will change to 6
 A.M.
- Mail will not be affected
