Wheaton Sanitary District (WSD) recognizes this Project has been difficult on the residents in the Pin Oak Court area, and would like to thank the residents for their patience and consideration during WSD's Northside Interceptor (NSI) Sewer Replacement Program as this very important project must be completed. The significant amount of heavy construction is ceasing shortly in your area for the winter, and now will take place in other areas along the NSI Route.

Restoration efforts thus far have included temporary hard-surface paving to allow for snow plowing, and re-installation of light posts and street signs. Speaking of street signs, you might have noticed that one is lower than normal. While WSD knows this Project has caused disturbances, since you've been so good, we wanted to make sure that Santa would be able to easily find your houses. So, having an "elf-height" street sign may help in that process.
