Dear Wheaton Residents:

This notice is an update on the work within Part C of the NSI project, which includes the area between Winfield Creek and Manchester Road.

Since the resolution of the Local 150 International Union of Operating Engineers strike on Tuesday, July 26th the General Contractor, Benchmark Construction, has resumed typical construction activities required to prepare Hazelton Avenue and Childs Street for Hot-Mix Asphalt (HMA) paving.

Benchmark will be ready to pave HMA Binder Course on Hazelton and Childs no later than next Friday, August 12th. Benchmark and their Subcontractors intend to work this Saturday, August 6th and through the first part of next week to remove existing pavement, prepare intersections, complete combination curb and gutter installation, complete subgrade preparation and aggregate base course installation, and install HMA Binder Course (paving) along Hazelton Avenue, north of Winfield Creek, and along Childs Street from Hazelton Avenue through Vernon Avenue.

WSD's priority remains to provide safe access through the construction area and maintain the site in an acceptable condition. Thank you for continued patience while Hazelton and Childs are restored.
