Dear Wheaton Residents:

This is a notice for residents within the North Side Interceptor (NSI) project area between Roosevelt Road and Manchester Road.

Wheaton Sanitary District (District) thanks you for your patience as the NSI project nears completion.

Sanitary sewer installation along Hazelton Avenue, Childs Street, and Knollwood Drive is complete. Sanitary sewer installation along Sunnybrook Lane and Dorchester Avenue will be complete by November 11<sup>th</sup>. Before the end of November, all pavements in this project area will be restored to hotmix asphalt (HMA) binder course, asphalt and concrete driveways will be reinstated, parkways will be graded and seeded, and construction equipment and materials will be minimized.

For the remainder of this year, and throughout the winter, the General Contractor (Benchmark Construction) plans to complete the remaining sanitary sewer improvements across Manchester Drive and along Winfield Creek. Benchmark will continue working throughout the project area to make sewer connections required to abandon the existing interceptor sewer and resolve construction deficiencies identified by the District.

As weather allows next spring, likely by mid-April, Benchmark will complete the HMA surface course installation, repair parkways that do not germinate, and complete remaining deficiencies identified by the District.
