STONEBRIDGE TRAIL AND SURROUNDING AREA RESIDENT UPDATE

WHEATON SANITARY DISTRICT IS NOTIFYING RESIDENTS THAT THE DETOUR ON STONEBRIDGE TRAIL HAS BEEN A “SOFT CLOSE,” MEANING EVEN THROUGH THE DETOUR IS THERE, VEHICLES ARE ABLE TO GET THROUGH. ON MONDAY, 11/15/21 AND TUESDAY, 11/16/21, IN ORDER FOR THE NORTHSIDE INTERCEPTOR SEWER TO GO IN, THERE WILL BE A “HARD CLOSE,” MEANING NO VEHICLES OR ANY TRAFFIC WILL BE ABLE TO GET THROUGH.

ON WEDNESDAY, 11/17/21 AND THURSDAY, 11/18/21, STONEBRIDGE TRAIL SHOULD BE BACK TO A “SOFT CLOSE,” BUT WORKERS WILL BE PUTTING DOWN TEMPORARY HARD SURFACE PAVEMENT. IT IS EXPECTED THAT THE STONEBRIDGE TRAIL DETOUR SHOULD BE REMOVED BY FRIDAY, 11/19/21.
